

VA FLOOD DISCLOSURE UPDATE

- A bill was introduced which seeks to achieve comprehensive flood risk disclosure in the Commonwealth (that could qualify for increased state-based CRS credits!)
 - Delegate Phil Hernandez is the patron of **HB 863**
- The bill will likely not move forward this year, but we anticipate an ad hoc working group, that incorporates the realtors, will be tasked with exploring this issue to bring back in 2025



2024 UPDATES

- \$135,000 to award in a single round
- Natural & Nature Based Infrastructure category
 - Green Infrastructure
 - Shoreline Protection
 - Tree Planting
- Funds could be used as match for eligible CFPF awards







COASTAL RESILIENCE & TREES FUND

- VA's <u>Coastal Zone</u>
- Civic groups, volunteer groups, educational institutions, tribal organizations, local governments, PDCs, regional councils, non-profit organizations, small businesses, & private citizens
- Installation projects should be shovel-ready
